### ***RICHARDSON<sup>2</sup>* - An Exhibition of Paintings by Father and Son**

Bob Richardson always had the tools and ideas of an artist. An unfinished sketchbook and his paintings from the 70's leaned on a wall next to a wood-burning stove. When his son Willy took the pursuit of painting seriously, it rekindled Bob's excitement for art and pushed him to reconsider how important it was to him. Painting facilitated a dialogue for abstract thinking and ideas between Bob and Willy Richardson and became a common ground for bonding. The wonderful by product of their art has been seeing each other, not just as father and son, but also as friends in the adult world (Although Bob insists, "he'll always be my son."). *Richardson<sup>2</sup>* is the celebration of this artistic relationship and the dialogue that permeates the work of this very special bond.
