Cinema and its Sisters
a free workshop for five Wednesdays starting September 5

To celebrate the launch of CCA's expanded Digital Media Arts program, we're offering a **free** class—Cinema and Its Sisters! This course is the perfect for those who'd like to become more conversant about or responsive to contemporary art. It's also a great primer for students thinking about taking one of our hands-on courses.

DIGITAL MEDIA ARTS SALON I: CINEMA AND ITS SISTERS

If it moves and it's a picture, it's probably a sister of cinema. This motion picture salon (our term for a relaxed, discussion-based class) is taught by two CCA Staffers--T. Foley and Martin Back--artists who engage in aesthetic practices that investigate new possibilities for making motion pictures. In this course we will explore some of the history, development and language of cinema beginning with early motion experiments (conducted by Muybridge and others) and concluding with super-contemporary screenings of works posted and distributed on YouTube. We'll view and conversationally consider motion picture texts as varied as scenes from famous musicals, and anime, video documentation of installation and performance art, and scenes from online video gaming worlds (such as Second Life).
